Dear Student (Parent/Carer)

I am delighted that you have chosen to continue to study at HGSC on the NVQ Level 2 Nail Technology, in Y13.

Students who are studying Nail Technology will need to purchase a compulsory kit. We understand that some students may already have some items, but it is a requirement that they work with specific items in the kit. The kit will consist of the following:-

Practice hand
Gel brush and fine liner brush
Tip cutters
Cuticle pusher
*Optional purchase: 1 grey tunic, 1 pair of grey trousers - (students can use the blue tunic and trousers from last year or may wish to purchase a new tunic and trousers)

The health and safety guidance for Nail Technology specifies that students must wear their tunic for practical sessions and bring their equipment to every lesson. They must wear flat, black, closed toe shoes, and black socks.

Adhering to health and safety legislation, jewellery is not to be worn; this includes facial piercings. Make-up must also be kept to a minimum and hair tied up, completely off the face. Nail extensions are not allowed for any practical; it is advised that these are not applied unless it is out of term time. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the student being unable to pass any practical assessment and losing their place on the course.

The total cost of the kit is £79.90 (including optional tunic and trousers) or £39.90 (not including tunic and trousers). A deposit of £30 must be made by Friday 4 September 2020. Our preferred method of payment is via ParentPay, please logon to your child's account. Full payment should be made by December 2020. Please complete the attached order/consent form.

It is vital that students carry out practical in this subject, and we will follow government, industry and school guidelines regarding working safely and Covid-19. To develop skills and build confidence students will act as models to perform treatments on each other, ready for commercial salon. Our commercial salon runs once a week (day to be confirmed) from 3-6pm and is part of their timetabled lesson in the subject; students should be present at their after-school twilight every week. Failure to attend and take part will result in losing their place on the course.

The following treatments will form part of the course, all students will be expected to carry out these tasks in order to pass the course. I (Parent/Carer) give permission for my child to carry out and receive the following treatments (please tick each one):

- Waxing (eyebrows, lip, chin, underarm, leg and bikini)
- Tinting (eyelashes and eyebrows)
- Skincare facials including neck/shoulder massage
- Manicure/gel application
- Pedicure
- Make-up services including special effects, body art and face paint
- Tanning services
- Body massage, using stone therapy, aromatherapy, and body electric massage
- Lash extensions (strip, flare and single lashes)
- Nail extensions (gel overlays fingers and toes) Soak off's
