Dear Parent/Carer

Due to an increase in the number of COVID-19 cases within the school, we are going to be making changes to some of the measures we have in place. Other schools in the county have had restrictions imposed upon them due to 'outbreaks' and, as always, we are trying to be proactive in our approach in order to prevent this from happening.

From **Tuesday 5 October 2021** (tomorrow), we are asking that all students bring a face covering to school with them and we would strongly encourage that these are worn in confined spaces with lots of traffic, such as corridors. We will also be suspending all assemblies for the time being to minimise the time that students are together in one large group.

It is also vital that students continue to observe good hand hygiene, ensuring that they all regularly wash/sanitise their hands and that they minimise physical contact as much as possible. Twice weekly testing, as reiterated in the letter that you received last week, also continues to be vitally important in helping us to reduce the spread of any infection.
