Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted that your child has chosen to study the Level 2 Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy course. Students will gain a Level 2 qualification which is equivalent to a GCSE and will also study towards a practical qualification through VTCT.

Students will need to purchase a hair and beauty tunic for the practical element of the course. These are £25 each. **Please pay for this via ParentPay** by logging in to your child's account. Once payment has been made please click on the link below to complete the tunic order form/consent form:-

The health and safety guidance for hair and beauty specifies that students must wear tunics for practical sessions and bring their equipment to every lesson. They must also wear flat black closed toe shoes, black trousers and black socks. Health and safety legislation also states that jewellery should not be worn and make-up must be kept to a minimum. Hair must be tied up, away from the face, and students must not wear artificial nails.

All students will be issued with a salon contract in due course. They will also achieve a VTCT (ITEC) Level 2 Award in Infection Prevention (COVID-19) for Beauty Therapy and Hairdressing. This is to ensure that they follow strict industry standards during practical. They will wear full PPE during practical, and will be observed by a qualified beauty therapist and assessor to ensure that they follow health and safety risk assessments.
