Year 10 Immersion Day Trip - Wednesday 9 February 2022

As referenced in the communication from Mr Huntington last week, we are providing all students with an enrichment activity as part of our next Immersion Day on Wednesday 9 February. Below are some further details regarding your child's trip.

Students will be visiting the Pioneer Centre in Kidderminster.

During the day students will be in groups and will take part in a range of outdoor activities from: abseiling, zip wire, high ropes, trek course, climbing, fan jump, archery, caving, challenge course and inflatable challenge.

Students will need to arrive at school at 08:10. We will be leaving school at approximately 08:30 and returning to school around 16:00.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them (lunch will be provided for free school meal students) and plenty of water as they will be doing lots of physical activity. **Please be aware that we have students who may be participating in this trip who have a serious nut allergy. Please avoid giving your son/daughter bagged nuts or products with a nut content, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety.**

Please ensure students are wearing sensible and warm active-wear clothing and trainers. In preparation for the weather please also ensure students bring a waterproof.

Students will not require any spending money.

We hope that you agree that this will be an engaging experience which will help to enrich our students, particularly given the restrictions that have been in place in recent years.

As we are working hard to provide an experience for all students, it is expected that all Year 10 students will participate in this activity. If there are extenuating circumstances around this, please contact your child's achievement leader in the first instance.
