**Year 8 Immersion Day Trip - Wednesday 9 February 2022**

As referenced in the communication from Mr Huntington last week, we are providing all students with an enrichment activity as part of our next Immersion Day on Wednesday 9 February. Below are some further details regarding your child's trip.

Students will spend the morning of the day at **Rollerworld Derby**, where they will spend 2 hours roller skating from 10.00am until 12.00pm. As part of their time at Rollerworld, students will also have the opportunity to eat their lunch. Students will then be collected by coach from Rollerworld at 12.30pm to travel to the **Regent Theatre, Stoke-on-Trent** for a matinee performance of the stage musical '**Jersey Boys**' which begins at 2.30pm. This show has won the prestigious Tony Award for Best Musical as well as a Grammy Award for Best Musical Theatre album.

Students will need to arrive at school at the usual time of 8.45am and are permitted to wear non-uniform for the day. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am and will be returning at around 6.30pm.

Students will be required to bring a packed lunch which will be eaten during the time spent at Rollerworld. Lunch will be provided for those students who are eligible for free school meals.

Please be aware that we have students who may be participating in this trip who have a serious nut allergy. Please avoid giving your child bagged nuts or products with a nut content, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety.

Students may wish to take some spending money to buy snacks and drinks which will be available at Rollerworld and the theatre. There will also be the opportunity to purchase merchandise related to the show if they wish.

We hope that you agree that this will be an engaging experience which will help to enrich our students, particularly given the restrictions that have been in place in recent years.

As we are working hard to provide an experience for all students, it is expected that all Year 8 students will attend the trip. If there are extenuating circumstances around this, please contact your child's achievement leader in the first instance.
