English Revision



Collective pronouns: unified in their responsibility/guilt

Active verb: conscious decision

Dismissive / innocent - links to attitudes towards social class and gender

“Between **us we** **drove** **that girl** to commit **suicide**” Sheila

Sheila is remorseful and is encouraging the other members of the family to admit their guilt

Emotive / blunt or graphic language - shock the audience

Sheila taking on the role of the Inspector
