Dear Parent/Carer

The school's CCF have been allocated two flying dates at RAF Cranwell on Friday 1 April 2022 and Friday 8 April 2022. Only eight places are available for each date. Priority will be given to those cadets who have yet to fly (providing they have passed their Part 1 Syllabus). This doesn't mean that your child is guaranteed to go flying but will be eligible for selection. Some cadets may get the opportunity to attend both dates, in this case, they will be selected at random.

Cadets should bring a packed lunch and something to drink, and also have had breakfast. They are to attend in working blue uniform (dark blue shirt) and should wear (or bring) soft soled shoes (not leather soled or metal tipped), trainers are fine and socks that cover the ankles and reach to mid-calf should be worn (female cadets are not to wear skirts). The cadet ID card is also required.

Sunglasses are recommended to be worn when airborne. On sunny days it is quite uncomfortable without them. Flying suit, helmet and gloves will be provided.

I won't know if flying will go ahead until 09.00 on the morning, so cadets are to attend school as normal with their school uniform and equipment in case flying is cancelled. Cadet uniform can be left in the CCF building. We will be leaving school at 09.00 returning at approximately 18.00. If we are delayed for any reason, students will be able to call home to inform you.

This trip is free. However, we do require parental consent in order for your child to attend. Please logon to your child's ParentPay account, click on this trip and complete the permission fields.
