WJEC Level 1/2 Award in Hospitality & Catering

I am writing to update you on the Year 11 Hospitality & Catering course that your child is studying. Students have been working on their written assessment which is the NEA (coursework). Personalised directed feedback will be returned to students this week with targets and areas to complete. It is really important for students to read the feedback and work on areas of development in order to gain marks needed to secure their grade. The NEA deadline is the 4 April.

In Year 10, due to the pandemic and school closures, this cohort of students did not sit the written exam element. Instead, students were awarded a teacher assessed grade which can be cashed in as their final grade. We have carefully considered the grades and have agreed that the score students received reflects their ability (all reached or exceeded target grades). It would be unfair and unnecessary added stress to expect students to take this formal exam when we have the option of using teacher assessed grades instead.

Finally, and most importantly, you will be aware that students completed a mock practical exam in December of 2021. They have their final practical exam week commencing 21 March. To give students the best possible chance of success, we have split the students into three groups so they will have more space around the kitchen. We will confirm groupings within the next few weeks.
