As part of the Immersion Day on Tuesday 28 June 2022, the Humanities Department have arranged a trip to the Thackray Museum of Science in Leeds for Year 10 History students.

Students will have the opportunity to revisit information from their Medicine through Time section of their history course. They will be able to wander through the grimy streets of Victorian Leeds, watch gruesome operations taking place in a 19th-century operating theatre, visit a seventies-style sexual health clinic, chart how well the world responds to crisis and discover the medical innovations that changed the world.

Students will need to be at school for 8.45am and will return for 3.00pm. They will need to wear their full school uniform and bring a pen, pencil and a ruler.
