### **University of Warwick Experience Day – Tuesday 28th June 2022**

In recent weeks through our Sixth Form tutor programme your son/daughter has begun to explore their post 18 options. This has covered a range of options including University, apprenticeships and studying abroad in order to ensure that all students are supported to make informed choices regarding decisions they make now that determine their future steps.

In order to give your child the best possible start to formalising their post 18 plans we have organised a visit to the University of Warwick. For those students who know university is their intended destination, a planned tour and workshops at a leading Russell Group University will be invaluable, and for those unsure of whether university is part of their plan, the day may help answer some questions and allay any concerns they have. There will also be sessions during the day designed to further student's understanding of apprenticeships, including higher and degree level apprenticeships, and therefore the day will be relevant to all year 12, regardless of current intentions.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 28th June 2022, which is the third and final immersion day for this academic year. Students will travel to and from the university by coach, along with members of the Sixth Form team. Students have been asked to arrive at Sixth Form for 8am and we aim to return at approximately 4:30pm. Lunch is not provided and students must bring their own packed lunch or money to purchase items within the onsite café. Students who receive free school meals can request a packed lunch from Monica Burrows.

All students are expected to attend this event and we hope that this visit, alongside other sessions your child is receiving through our Sixth Form tutor programme, will help them end year 12 with a clear plan regarding post 18 destinations.
