Dear Parent/Carer

Following on from my letter at the beginning of this week, I would now like to share with you the Year 10 mock examination timetable which will begin on Wednesday 22 June.

In exactly 12 months' time your child will be sitting their GCSE examinations. Our Year 10 mock programme will replicate the format of the current Year 11 experience and, in the core subjects, will include examinations set centrally by the Spencer Academies Trust. This helps ensure the assessments are robust and that the results can be used accurately to guide decisions around subject class sets, intervention groups and predicted grades for Year 11. Therefore, it is of paramount importance that our students are well prepared both mentally and physically to enable them to perform to the best of their ability.

The attached timetable has been shared with students in tutor time today and a 'student friendly' version detailing their pre-exam preparation lessons will be issued to them towards the end of next week. Some BTEC and other vocational subjects will not appear on the timetable, as the assessment cycle for these courses is different and therefore students will continue their course work in these lessons.

Your support is invaluable in your child's success. Can we ask that you talk to your child about the timetable and their revision plans, ensuring they understand the importance of these exams as we progress into Year 11.
