Dear Parent/Carer

Given the anticipated weather warning given for early next week around extreme heat, we have tried to anticipate how we can support students to remain safe and comfortable in school.

We are well aware that the buildings with the poorest insulation are the main teaching blocks (D/E) and so we have reallocated classrooms away from this block. We are also suggesting that blazers be left at home next week and based on the temperatures we will make a decision around the omissions of ties on a day-by-day basis if we feel this will support students further. Students will also be given regular opportunities to refill water bottles and will be encouraged to stay hydrated. Please ensure your child has a water bottle with them.

Students on school trips or are involved in 'Take Your Child To Work Day' will wear non-uniform and they are advised to think carefully about their choice of outfit to offer protection from the sun and heat. Students also need to ensure that they have adequate sunscreen and that they reapply this when necessary.

So that everyone is clear, uniform expectations for students on the school site will vary based on year group activities. Please refer to the table below to ensure your child is dressed appropriately.
