Dear Parent/Carer

Thanks to everyone who supported last night's Heanor Fest; it was great to see another of our big events return post-pandemic. On Friday we have our annual sports day and we wanted to communicate some key information with you.

- 1) The weather forecast looks good and is likely to be in the low-twenties in terms of temperature. There will be shaded areas and opportunities to refill water bottles, however it is imperative that students bring with them a water bottle and also have access to their own sun screen. They may also want to bring a hat. We will also provide an opportunity to buy water and ice lollies using cash, outside of the usual breaks/lunchtimes.
- 2) Students **must** wear their HGSA PE kit. This includes their white t-shirt and navy shorts (females may wear plain black or navy sports leggings). No tracksuit bottoms, branded t shirts, hoodies or variations from the school PE kit will be permitted. Students have been made aware of this and will be sent home to change if they arrive in items that are not permitted. Any students with medical conditions who have a pre-agreed kit variation will, of course, be permitted to wear what has been arranged through their reasonable medical adjustments.
