This morning Mr Huntington and I had a very productive meeting with a group of students that included your son/daughter. The meeting was regarding sitting GCSE Biology, GCSE Chemistry and GCSE Physics separately instead of Combined Science: Trilogy.

We explained in detail the benefits of the individual courses but also some of the reasons why it might not be suitable to some individuals.

From past and current data, classroom and exam performance, we feel it would be beneficial for your son/daughter to sit this course.

The separate science courses covers topics in more depth and a broader range of content; therefore, is the best route to go into a Science A level course or for a more academic future pathway. Your child will also receive three separate GCSE qualifications from doing this. The elements of the science separate course are taught by biology, chemistry and physics specialists.

All of the students appear to be in favour and have had the opportunity for individual conversations should they wish to do so.
